

MODEL 8010 JAR ROLLER

1 DESCRIPTION

The 8010 Jar Roller is used to rotate jars of adhesive paste to maintain uniformly mixed, bubble-free material while stored at room temperature. The speed of rotation (about 2 rpm) is high enough to maintain homogeneity of jar contents and low enough to prevent centrifuging and separation of contents.

KEY FEATURES AND SPECIFICATIONS

- Provides for consistent, optimized adhesive application and performance
- Eliminates or reduces manual mixing or deaeration
- Minimizes solvent evaporation caused by opening jar for manual mixing
- Contains six metal rollers which rotate at about 2 rpm
- Rollers are 28.0 cm long x 2.9 cm diameter (11" x 1.1"), spaced 1.0 cm (0.4") apart
- Holds up to 30 jars of ½ fluid ounce size
- Accommodates jars as large as 32 fluid oz. (1 quart) or 1 liter or greater
- Operates on 120 V, 60 Hz, 0.6 A, at approximately 60dB
- Approximate dimensions: 40.6 x 25.4 x 19.1 cm
 16" long x 10" wide x 7½" high
- Shipping weight approximately 8.6 kg (19 pounds)

OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS AND SERVICE PARTS LIST

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Please read instructions before using.
- 2. Keep machine clean at all times.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

 Use an appropriate electrical outlet capable of supplying 120 VAC, 60 Hz, 0.6 A.

PREPARATION

- 1. Set unit on a level surface.
- 2. Position unit near a power outlet. Avoid the use of extension cords.
- 3. Clean unit as needed before use, using a dry, lint-free towel.

OPERATION

- 1. Plug machine into power outlet and rollers will begin turning.
- 2. To stop rollers, unplug machine from the outlet.

CLEANING

NOTE: Proper maintenance plays an important part in the life span and functioning of the unit.

- 1. Plug machine in and clean with a dry, lint-free towel.
- 2. Start at the end of rollers and wipe toward the center.
